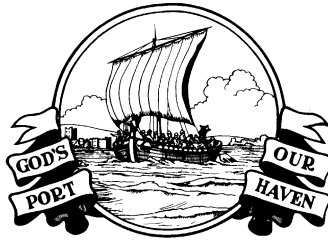

Purpose

To consider a request that former Councillor Keith Cyril Farr be appointed an Honorary Alderman.

Recommendation

That former Councillor Keith Cyril Farr be appointed an Honorary Alderman.

1.0 Report

- 1.1 Councillor Cully has requested that the Council consider appointing former Councillor Keith Farr as an Honorary Alderman.
- 1.2 The Council has the power to make such appointments on persons who have in the opinion of the Council rendered eminent services to the Council as past members of the Council. The appointment is made at an extraordinary Council meeting called for the purpose of considering the appointment.
- 1.3 Former Councillor Farr was a Councillor for the Elson Ward from 1999-2002, Forton Ward from 2002 until 2008 and again between May 2012 and May 2016 and Town Ward between 2016 and 2021.
- 1.4 He has served on many of the Committees and Boards of the Council and was Mayor in 2015-2016.
- 1.5 The Policy and Organisation Board, at their meeting on the 29th September 2021 agreed to recommend to Council that the appointment be made.
