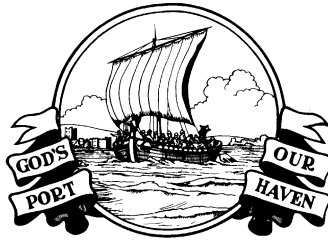

### **1.0 Report**

- 1.1 Councillor Burgess has requested that the Council consider appointing former Councillor Chris Carter as an Honorary Alderman.
- 1.2 The Council has the power to make such appointments on persons who have in the opinion of the Council rendered eminent services to the Council as past members of the Council. The appointment is made at an extraordinary Council meeting called for the purpose of considering the appointment.
- 1.3 Former Councillor Carter was a Conservative Councillor for the Lee West Ward from 2002 until May 2022.
- 1.4 He has served on many of the major Committees and Boards of the Council and was Mayor in 2011-2012. He also Chaired the Regulatory Board.
