

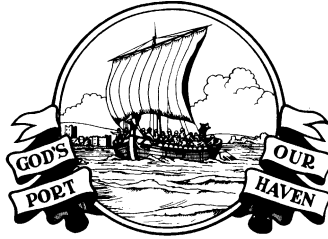

1.0 Report

- 1.1 Councillor Chegwyn has requested that the Council consider appointing former Councillor Robert Whitbread as an Honorary Alderman.
- 1.2 The Council has the power to make such appointments on persons who have in the opinion of the Council rendered eminent services to the Council as past members of the Council. The appointment is made at an extraordinary Council meeting called for the purpose of considering the appointment.
- 1.3 Former Councillor Whitbread was a Liberal Democrat Councillor for the Elson Ward from 1988 until May 1996.
- 1.4 He served on many Committees and was the Vice Chair of the Health & Housing Committee
