- 1.1 Councillor Chegwyn has requested that the Council consider appointing former Councillor Bob Whitbread as an Honorary Alderman.
- 1.2 The Council has the power to make such appointments on persons who have in the opinion of the Council rendered eminent services to the Council as past members of the Council. The appointment is made at an extraordinary Council meeting called for the purpose of considering the appointment. This will be held at a date in the near future.
- 1.3 Former Councillor Whitbread was a Liberal Democrat Councillor for the Elson Ward from 1988 until May 1996.
- 1.4 He has served on many of the major Committees and Boards of the Council and was Mayor's consort in 1994-1995.
