This needs to be undertaken constructively, actively and on an ongoing basis to maximise the effectiveness of Local Plan preparation in the context of strategic cross boundary matters.</p>	<p>To provide clarity that built heritage is clearly identified as an important issues in the Duty to Co-operate.</p>

Repeat this change for tables 2, 3 and 4.</p>	<p>Normally the Discovery Centre and Bridgemary Library have been able to host consultation material including exhibitions in their facilities. However, there may be occasions when this is not possible and therefore other locations would need to be found. For the avoidance doubt, it is considered more prudent to include them under the discretionary measures along with the community libraries at Lee-on-the-Solent and Elson rather than include them as part of the Council's minimum requirements.</p>

Once submitted the Council will then publicise the Neighbourhood Plan's proposals as required by The Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (as amended). The Council undertakes consultation on the final submission version of the Neighbourhood Plan and organises the referendum. <u>At each stage of consultation key stakeholders (as identified in Appendix 1) will be consulted along with other interested groups and organisations.</u> The Council will have prepared a number of evidence studies and other material in the preparation of DPDs and SPDs which may be of assistance in the preparation of Neighbourhood Plans.</p>	To provide clarity regarding who will be consulted.
